Electronics Collection on April 23 in Celebration of Earth Day

In honor of Earth Day, the Village of Deerfield has partnered with the Solid Waste Agency of Lake County (SWALCO) and Walgreens Corporate to provide an electronics collection on April 23 at Walgreens Corporate Campus at 1435 Lake Cook Road from 7 a.m. to 1 p.m. This collection is open to anyone who would like to drop off their residential electronics.

Electronic items that will be accepted are: computer equipment, including personal computers, monitors, keyboards, laptops, printers, hand-held computer games, video games; home electronics & small appliances, including TVs, VCRs, cameras, radios, speakers, CD players, vacuums, hair dryers, sewing machines, and microwaves; home office equipment, including typewriters, fax machines, scanners, calculators, paper shredders, telephones, answering machines, cell phones and; household batteries, including alkaline and rechargeable batteries.

On January 1, 2012, the Illinois Electronic Products Recycling and Reuse Act landfill ban for certain electronic devices took effect. Electronic items such as televisions, monitors, computers and printers are some of the most common items that will no longer be allowed in the regular trash. If residents cannot make it to the April 23 event, the Village is hosting several more electronic collection events throughout the year at the Village's Public Works Facility (465 Elm Street):
