56th Annual Deerfield Family Days Kicking off July 3 & 4

Deerfield Family Days will take place on Wednesday, July 3 and Thursday, July 4. Join family, friends and community members at this annual event to celebrate Independence Day with fun, food and entertainment.

The spectacular fireworks show will be held Wednesday at Brickyards Park with rides, games and live entertainment. The gates will open at 5 p.m., and food and drink concessions will be available for purchase. Admission is free. Unlimited ride wristbands are available for \$10 and cannot be reused on July 4. Fireworks begin at dusk.

On Thursday, head on over to the festivities at Jewett Park including a pancake breakfast, arts and crafts bazaar, flower show, dog show, rides, games, live entertainment, a petting zoo and concessions. Admission is free. Unlimited ride wristbands are available for \$15 with cash only. Also visit Maplewood Park (new race route) for the Rotary Club race, registration starting at 7:15 a.m. The parade starts at noon and will travel from Deerspring Pool, west on Deerfield Road, north on Waukegan Road, west onto Hazel and will end on Park Avenue.
