The Citizen's Police Academy is a ten-week program designed to enhance communication between the police department and the community. Participants receive instruction on a vast array of topics taught by officers who hold specialties in various aspects of law enforcement. In addition, participants have the option of riding with an officer on patrol and partaking in hands on activities.

#### Class Sessions

Classes are held Thursday evenings from 7:00 PM to 9:30 PM at the Police Department. The ten-week session will be offered spring, 2019. Classes will start March 14<sup>th</sup> and run through May 23<sup>rd</sup>. There will be no class held the week of March 28<sup>th</sup>. The session is limited to 14 participants to facilitate discussion.

- Lives or works in Deerfield
