BOIL ORDER LIFTED

The boil water order for Deerfield water customers has been lifted in accordance with IEPA protocol and guidelines. The Village conducted a series of water tests since Monday afternoon and all samples have come back clear of any fecal coliform. Residents and business are advised that water can be used in a regular manner.

The Village will continue to regularly monitor the water system in accordance with IEPA requirements.

What should I do now that the boil order has been lifted?

The Lake County Health Department advises water customers should:

1. Flush the building water lines and clean faucet screens.
2. Purge all water-using fixtures and appliances of standing water and ice such as refrigerator ice makers or coffee makers.
