## **Storm Update 2**

At this time, the Village of Deerfield continues to experience widespread power outages. Village of Deerfield officials have been in contact with ComEd and have been notified that ComEd is focusing work on repairing feeders at this time. Residents should expect power to remain out over night. Some residents may experience an outage that lasts more than 48 hours. Due to the number of trees making contact with power lines, it is unknown at what time in the restoration process different areas of town will have power.

The Village continues to encourage residents to call ComEd at 1-800-EDISON-1 (1-800-334-7661) to report power outages and to get updates on restoration times. ComEd is not always aware that an individual home's power is out.

Residents should stay away from downed power lines and call 911 if they witness fires or dangerous conditions.

Public Works crews worked hard over night and through the day today to clear roads of debris. The Village will be providing a special pick up service for downed tree limbs on private residential property through Friday. Residents should have their limbs at the curb prior to 7AM on Friday. Any residents that have downed trees should contact a private contractor for removal of the tree.

The Village will continue to update the website and issue press releases as information becomes available.
