47th ANNUAL DEERFIELD FAMILY DAYS

Deerfield Family Days will take place on Saturday, July 3 and Sunday, July 4. Join family and friends at this annual event for a holiday weekend filled with fun, food, and entertainment.

The spectacular fireworks show will be held Saturday at Brickyards Park with food concessions and live entertainment from Bizar Entertainment. Bizar Entertainment of Deerfield will provide a DJ that will play music from the 60's to 2000's. They will have dancers interacting with the crowd and there will be contests for hula-hoops, limbo and sing-a-longs. Jason Kollum, a stilt walker-juggler will be entertaining the crowd, and our own Elaine Silberman will do face painting. The gates will open at 5:00 p.m. and admission is free.

On Sunday, head on over to the festivities at Jewett Park including a pancake breakfast, arts and crafts sale, flower show, dog show, rides, games, bands, petting zoo, and concessions. Pre-sale of wristbands will be available at Deerfield Village Hall and the Deerfield Park District for \$8.00 until July 2nd. Wristband will be for sale at Jewett Park on July 4th for \$10.00 per person. The parade starts at noon. The Rotary 10K race begins at Walden School at 8 a.m., and the bike parade is at 8 a.m. at Rosemary & Deerfield Roads – come with your bikes pre-decorated!
