Village of Deerfield Honors Bernard Forrest

The Village of Deerfield honors Bernard “Bernie” Forrest, former long-term Mayor of Deerfield, who passed away on August 21, 2018. Black bunting can be seen adorning Village Hall the week of August 27 in memoriam of Forrest.

Forrest served as a Deerfield Trustee for four years and was elected Mayor in 1969, a position that he held for 32 years. Due to his influences and years of service, Village Hall is named in his honor. Forrest passed away at the age of 89.
