Deerfield Public Art Program Open House September 26, 2018

The Deerfield Fine Arts Commission will host a community open house to showcase the 24 pieces selected for the fifth year of the Deerfield Public Art Program before they are put on display throughout the Village.

The event will be held in the Deerfield Public Library, 920 Waukegan Road, from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. on Wednesday, September 26, and will feature many of the artists who created this year's pieces. Light refreshments will be served.

Multiple media are featured in this year's selections. Artists from Deerfield include Shayna Elekman, Sara Kenward, Avra Mouzakis, Wayne Rhodes, Linda Trytek, Penny Weinberg, and Susan Willis. Other artists include Noel Ash of Madison, Wisc., Elisa Boughner of Glenview, Susan Harrold of Oak Park, ISz of Chicago, Judith Joseph of Northbrook, Renata Maliszewski of Northbrook, Victor Nelson of Evanston, Jim Parks of Evanston, Play Big! (Andrea Jablonski and Laura Miracle) of Chicago, Alix Anne Shaw of Chicago, Frank Vega of Chicago, and Jamie Weinfurter of Wisconsin Rapids, Wisc. The artists will discuss their work and answer questions from the public in a new "Meet the Artist" forum at the open house.

The specific artwork selected for display were chosen from submissions by a very talented pool of artists and were reviewed via jury process. The Fine Arts Commission is responsible for reviewing artwork submissions and making a final recommendation. The artists have agreed to loan their works of art for public display for up to one year.

Pieces from last year's Public Art Program will remain on display until the open house.
